Stay Healthy This Winter And Remember

Keep your hands away from your face. Flu viruses enter the body through the eyes, nose or mouth.

Cough and sneeze into your arm, not your hand. If you use a tissue, dispose of it as soon as possible and wash your hands.

Wash your hands frequently with soap and warm water for at <u>least</u> <u>20 seconds</u> to help remove bacteria and viruses. Wash before and after eating, after you have been in a public place, after using the washroom, after coughing and sneezing and after touching surfaces that may have been contaminated. An alcoholbased hand sanitizer is also effective in killing viruses.

Keep common surface areas clean and disinfected. Doorknobs, light switches, telephones, keyboards, TV remotes, fridge door handles and other surfaces can become contaminated with all kinds of bacteria and viruses. Regular cleaning and disinfecting of these surfaces with normal household disinfectants can help. Viruses can live on hard surfaces for up to 48 hours.
