Essex 2: In-Suite Water Shutoff

Water shut off valves are located under the washroom sink, behind cylindrical covers. Each valve operates independently and there is a separate valve for each hot and cold water line.

Depending on the size of your unit, you may have 1 or 2 pairs of shut off valves under each sink in each bathroom.



Tools required:



- 1. Flat blade screwdriver (optional)
- 2. **T-Handle wrench** provided to original owners on possession.

If necessary, a replacement is available at the Management Office at a cost of \$15.00.

To shut off the valve:

- 1. Remove the cylindrical cover from each valve by pulling the cover towards you. The covers are held in by a light spring tension. If necessary, use a small flat blade screw driver to pry it away from the drywall.
- 2. Insert the T-Handle shutoff wrench into the valve cylinder and line it up with the square valve head.



- For **OFF**, turn the wrench clockwise about 1 and ½ turns until you feel the valve stop. The valve is now closed. Repeat on the other valves.
- To **OPEN**, turn the T-Handle wrench counter clockwise about 1 and ½ turns until you feel the valve stop. The valve is now open.
- 3. Once all water valves have been opened, replace the cylindrical cover by lining up the tabs with the cylinder and press in.
